### **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EoI)**

National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from competent person(s)/ firms/ companies for conducting a detailed **feasibility study for establishment of Common Facility Centre (CFC) for value added fish products at IFFCO-KISSAN SEZ, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh**. The offer has to be submitted in two envelopes – one containing details of technical capabilities and another containing the financial bid. The last date for receiving the bid is 3.30 PM on 05-02-2010 at NFDB office. There shall be a pre bid meeting on the same day at 4.00 pm at NFDB's office. ## **Details of the proposed feasibility study:**

1. National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad intends to explore the possibilities of establishing a Common Facility Centre (CFC) for value added fish products at IFFCO-KISAN SEZ being developed at Rachelapadu village (20 km north of Nellore town), Nellore, Andhra Pradesh in an area of about 150 acres. NFDB proposes to purchase this land from IFFCO Kisan SEZ at appropriate rate, develop a common facility centre and lease/sell it to industries related to fisheries especially those involved in production of value added fish products for domestic and foreign markets.
2. The feasibility study shall examine the following issues
  - a) Whether it is technically feasible, economically viable, socially acceptable and environmentally safe to establish CFC at IFFCO-Kisan SEZ Nellore, AP, taking into account:
    - Location,
    - Existing infrastructure – water, electricity, communication facilities, transportation, etc.
    - Availability of quality and quantity of requisite raw material.
    - Possible marketing net-works across the country and demand for value fish products within and outside the country.
    - Scope for attracting sufficient number of entrepreneurs for establishing the industry
    - Possible ways and means of attracting the entrepreneurs.
    - Terms and conditions of IFFCO- Kisan SEZ
    - Existing rules and regulations of Union / State Government and Bye-laws of NFDB etc.
  - b) If establishment of CFC is techno-economically found to be viable, the modalities of purchasing the land, building the common facility centre and required infrastructure (identification of required facilities), establishment of industries for production of value added fish products including assessment of financial commitment for CFC.
  - c) Possible additional transport, handling, storage, packing and marketing facilities required
  - d) Involving other institutes, organizations, and private entrepreneurs in implementing the project
  - e) The study should analyze the time series data relating to Indian and global markets for establishing CFC.

- f) The schemes for financial assistance available to investors from various organizations of Government of India, Government of Andhra Pradesh and NFDB
3. The person/ persons/ firms/ companies interested to conduct this feasibility study must have experience of working on similar projects for at least last 5 years, must have conducted at least 5 similar studies involving an investment of not less than Rs. 100 crores and besides others, must have an expert in the field of fish processing and marketing.
  4. The interested person/ persons/ firms/ companies shall express their interest in conducting the feasibility study by submitting two envelopes containing: (i) Technical bid indicating their experience, knowledge and competency in taking up such studies along with copies of two similar studies conducted by them. (ii) Financial bid indicating the amount for the study including travel cost, allowances, printing of reports and tax.
  5. The technical bid will be opened first and if found eligible, then only the financial bid will be opened. The suitable bidder will be selected based on both technical and financial bids by a panel of experts. If required, the bidders will be requested to make a presentation of their proposal to panel of experts.
  6. The study shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of awarding the work.
  7. The rate and cost of study shall be competitive and subject to further negotiations if found suitable.
  8. The Study report should be to the best one upto the satisfaction of the National Fisheries Development Board(NFDB) and any modifications, inclusions and exclusions shall be incorporated without any additional cost and it should be within the cost.
  9. The selected person/ persons/ firms/ company shall enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with NFDB and it should abide by the conditions laid down in the MoU.
  10. The NFDB reserves the right of terminating the EoI at any time in the process without assigning any reason.
